

What began in 1937 as a professional organization for faculty at Pennsylvania's Teacher Colleges has grown into an organization touching the lives of over 105,000 students and their families each year.

Today, APSCUF (the Association of Pennsylvania State College and University Faculties) represents the 6,000 faculty members and coaches employed at Pennsylvania's 14 publicly owned universities — the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education. Our faculty members provide education in 217 undergraduate and 107 graduate degree programs, as well as numerous certification and continuing education programs. APSCUF members instruct the state's future leaders in business, government, the military, education, service and technology sectors as well as numerous industries.

The State System's students are APSCUF's top priority. When students choose a State System institution, they can be sure they will have professors teaching all their classes, not graduate assistants. In addition, APSCUF faculty members teach more hours than professors at state-related universities (Penn State, Pittsburgh, Temple, and Lincoln). Further, System students can be confident in the fact that they will be assigned regular faculty members as their advisors, not part-time administrators.

APSCUF has also insisted that students deserve continuing faculty, not "here today, gone tomorrow" temporary faculty that have become fashionable at most cost-cutting universities.

One in 34 Pennsylvania citizens is attending or has graduated from a State System University. The 435,000 State System Alumni repay Pennsylvania's investment in higher education, as nearly 70 percent of State System graduates remain in the state after graduation. By helping to provide affordable quality education, APSCUF members contribute greatly to Pennsylvania's growth and development.

Faculty impact extends far beyond the classroom. Each year, APSCUF members volunteer more than 715,000 hours of public service and charitable work. From fundraising to helping the homeless, they offer their time and talents to help solve society's problems. They also touch countless lives through continuing education, outreach programs, small business development, technological guidance, offerings in the arts and recreational planning.

Through their contributions both in the classroom and beyond, APSCUF members bring improved quality of life through higher education to millions of people.
